



CURBSIDE RECYCLING FOR LOWER MACUNGIE TOWNSHIP RESIDENCES (Those included with the Township Waste Contract)

ALL HOUSEHOLDS MUST USE THE AUTOMATED RECYCLING CART PROVIDED BY THE TOWNSHIP

Materials	What Is Collected	What Is NOT Collected	Recycling Preparations
Glass	Clear, brown and green bottles & jars. Examples~ beverage bottles, food containers	Windows & plate glass, light bulbs, crystal, Pyrex, & ceramic	Remove the caps. Rinse out bottles and containers. Do not break. Place in Township supplied cart.
Paper	Newspaper & mixed paper (junkmail) glossy ads, magazines, telephone books, office paper, fiber egg boxes	Food wrappings, shredded paper	Place in Township supplied cart.
Cans	Aluminum, steel, & bi-metal cans Examples~ soda and soup cans	Foil, aluminum tubing, oil or aerosol cans	Rinse cans. Place in Township supplied cart.
Plastics	PETE & HDPE Examples- soda, milk, juice, water & cleaning bottles	All plastics without recycling logo, "foam" containers	Rinse containers. Place in Township supplied cart.
Paper Board	All non corrugated & corrugated cardboard. Examples - cereal boxes, shipping boxes	Plastic coated paper boards. Example - milk cartons. Pizza boxes contaminated with grease	Place in Township supplied cart. Flatten if necessary to fit in cart.
White Goods	One Large Appliance Cannot be combined with other bulk or construction bundles in same week.	Any refrigerant items that have not been tagged as having the refrigerant removed	"Freon" \ refrigerant must be removed from air conditioners, refrigerators, freezers, dehumidifiers etc by authorized firm and tagged. After item is tagged, refer to lowermac.com Trash & R/C Request Form for BULK COLLECTIONS.
<p><u>Yard Waste (see A to Z Guide for definition of YARD WASTE)</u> Collected curbside 12 times per year every other week from end of April to end of September. Day after regular trash day. Yard Waste cannot be included with regular trash. OR, Yard Waste may be taken to the Yard Waste Recycle Center. PERMIT IS REQUIRED.</p>			
<p><u>Grass Clippings Curbside Collection</u> Collected curbside from Mid-March to beginning of October. Day after regular trash day. Must be in 30 gallon kraft paper bags, maximum 5 bags. Grass only in the bags, do NOT mix with yard waste</p>

Home Parks, Apartments/Condos/ Businesses		Unlimited weekly household trash see below for items limited to (1) per week	After 5PM of the night before your scheduled collection	To the curb or end of your driveway on public roads.	Tied or covered securely in bags or containers not to exceed 35 gal.or 60 lbs. NO cardboard boxes / 55 gal. drums / 90 gal. totes
Waste Management	Cat Litter	unlimited weekly household trash	same as above	same as above	Must be contained. Do not dump loose litter
Waste Management	** Construction Materials including carpet, drywall etc.	Only (1) CONTAINER OR BUNDLE PER WEEK not to exceed 60 lbs./ no larger than 2ft.x4ft. pcs.	same as above	same as above	Carpet, wood (including pressure treated), drywall etc. must be bundled or placed in one container
Waste Management	**Bulk items... Furn.,Mattress,Lg. Appliances, Car tires (not on rim) etc.	Only ONE BULK OR CONSTRUCTION MATERIAL ITEM OR LG. APPLIANCE PER WEEK	same as above	same as above	Place with trash separate from recycling.
Waste Management	Non-Hazardous Liquids (i.e. frying oil) Latex Paint ONLY	unlimited weekly household trash	same as above	same as above	Let cans dry out then place in trash or stuff with shred.paper or cat litter to absorb liquids. NOTHING IN LIQUID FORM CAN BE PLACED AT CURBSIDE
Waste Management	Medical "Sharps"	unlimited weekly household trash	same as above	same as above	Place needles in hard plastic container with screw top lid. (i.e.) laundry det. Bottles - then place in trash OR utilize the AT YOUR DOOR SERVICE from Waste Management (see Ewaste/HHW page)
Waste Management	Prescription Drugs	unlimited weekly household trash	same as above	same as above	Take out of original containers.Dissolve in boiling water then mix in with undesirable substance i.e. cat litter or coffee grounds then roll in newspaper and place in trash. Only flush in toilet if the label specifically states this.Check with FDA for a list of drugs where toilet disposal is acceptable. Or visit www.deadiversion.usdoj.gov for more info.

****Go to lowermac.com/Departments/Public Works/Recycling/trash form and notify Waste Management of your bulk item or large appliances/construction material for collection**

****In the event of an entire house requiring clean out due to relocation or death, etc... be advised this is not considered "weekly household trash" under our contract with Waste Management. Excessive trash placed at curbside may not be collected by Waste Management and could result in citations being issued. Please contact Waste Management by using the form located at www.lowermac.com>Public Works>Trash & Recycling>Trash & Recycling Form and request information on how to dispose of excessive trash and bulk items in these circumstances or, if you prefer, you may hire another contractor to make arrangements for the disposal.**
